## VERMONT STATE FACTS:

- The capital of Vermont is Montpelier, the smallest state capital in the U.S., and the only capital without a McDonald's restaurant.
- Vermont's State House has a dome covered in real gold and fossils in the marble floors.
- Vermont was the first state to recognize civil unions, and the first to pass marriage equality for LGBTQ+ people through its Legislature. (2009)
- Vermont was the first state to prohibit adult slavery in its constitution (1777) and was home to stops along the Underground Railroad.
- President Calvin Coolidge was born in Vermont on the Fourth of July, the only U.S. president with that birth date.
- Lake Champlain was named after French navigator Samuel de Champlain.
- The first chairlift for skiing in Vermont was used on Mount Mansfield, Vermont's tallest mountain at 4,393 feet. (1940)
- It takes 40 gallons of sap to make one gallon of pure Vermont maple syrup.
- Vermont is the lead producer of maple syrup in the U.S., making as much as two million gallons each year.

- Vermont's forests are more than $70 \%$ maple trees, making the state famous for its bright fall foliage.
- The world's deepest dimension granite quarry is Rock of Ages in Barre and its mineralized green waters plunge 400 feet deep.
- Vermont has its own fossil reef, Chazy Reef in Isle La Motte.
- Vermont is home to the country's first through-hiking trail, the 272-mile Long Trail.
- Vermont has 55 state parks and one national park, Marsh-Billings-Rockefeller National Historic Park.
