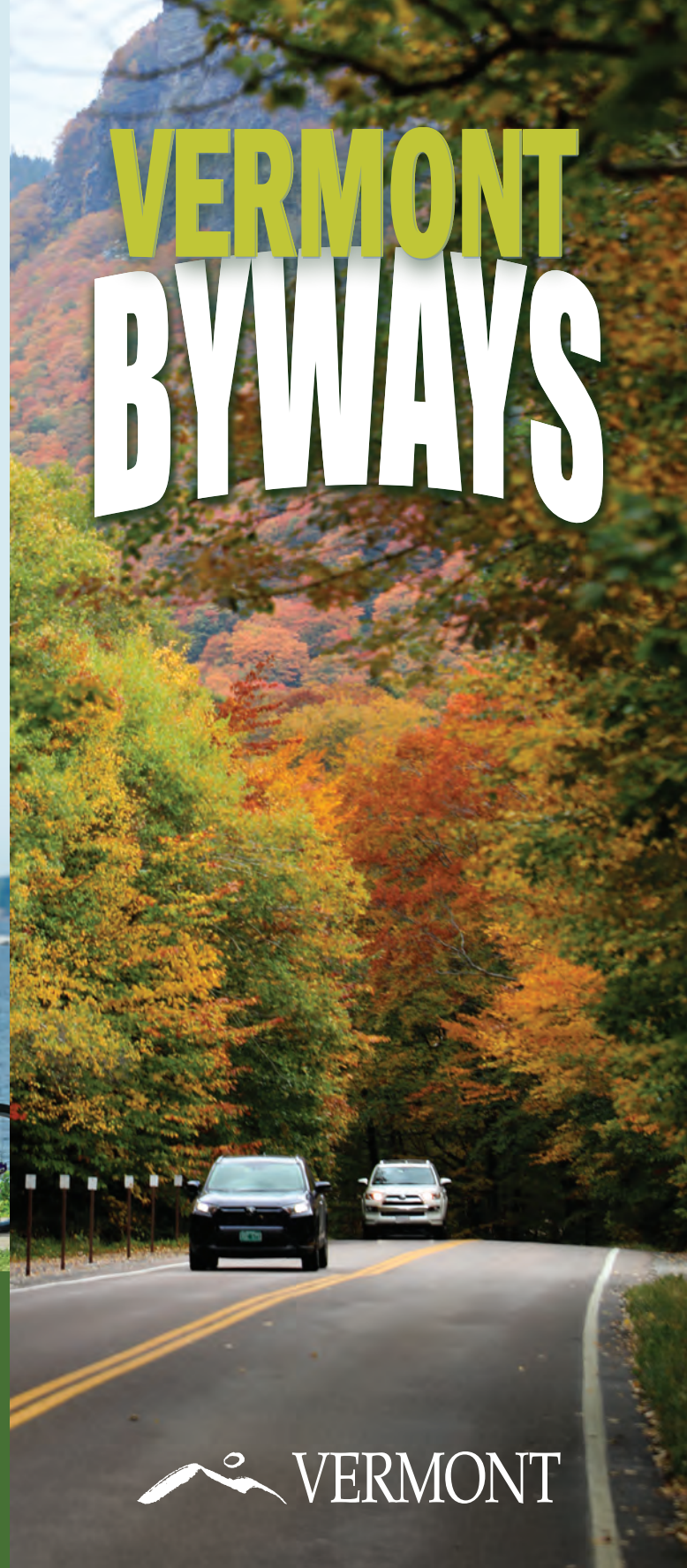

One of the best ways to experience Vermont is touring the roads that connect the mountains and valleys. These routes lead through forests and farmland to historic villages and towns. Along the way, discover vibrant hubs of culture, commerce, and recreation.

Vermont's 10 designated byways range in length from 30 miles to more than 400 miles. You could spend an afternoon, a weekend, or longer exploring.

Tour byways by car, motorcycle, or bicycle. Visit museums, galleries, antique shops, and boutiques. Trails, waterfalls, and valley views await travelers at every bend.

Discover festivals, outdoor events, and more. Savor the Green Mountain State at farm stands and tasting centers. Each stop along the way creates memories that linger long after the vacation ends.

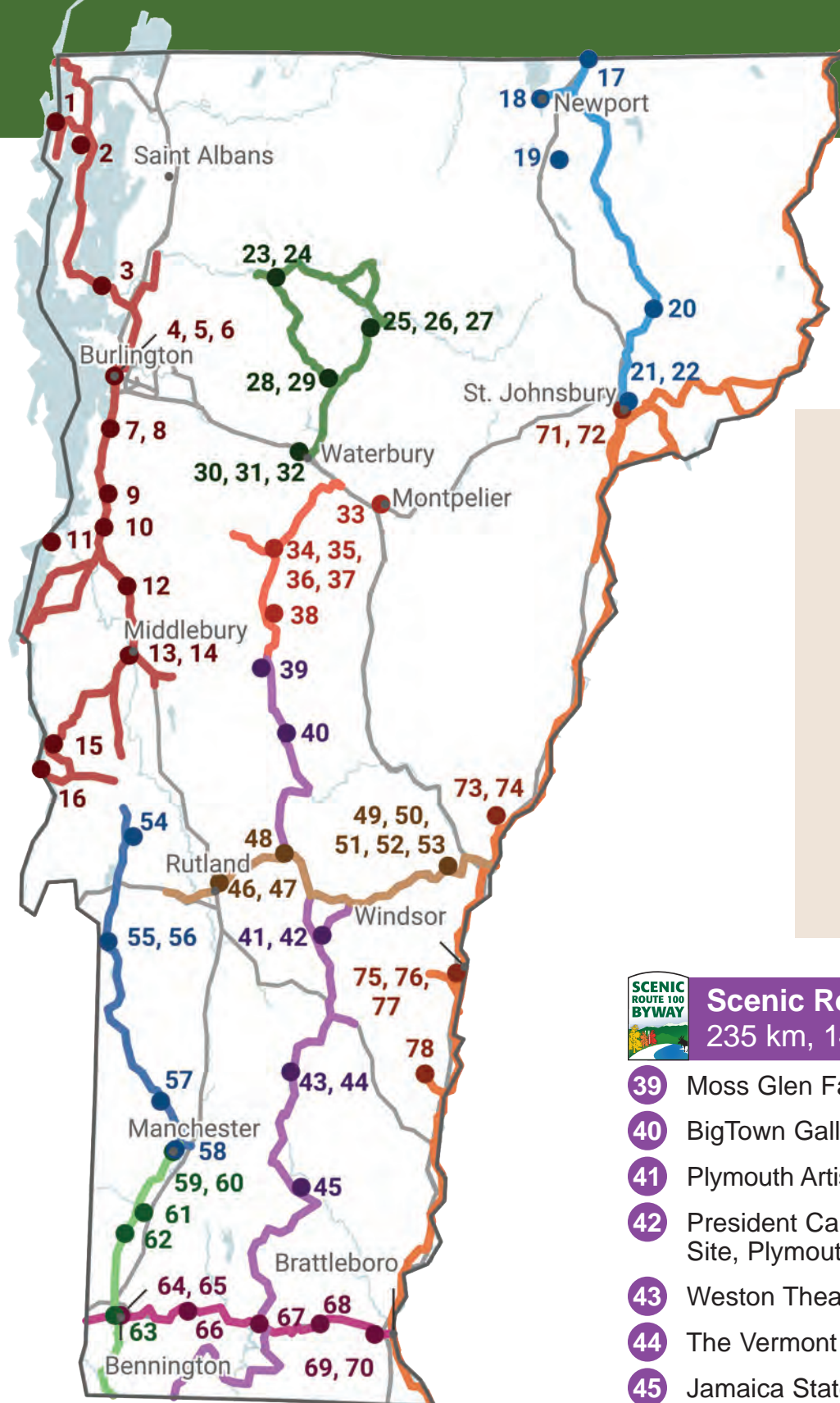
